Christmas at The Salisbury Museum

Calling all LEGO® brick fans! The Salisbury Museum will be holding a giant LEGO® building brick event at the museum on Saturday 9 December. Having previously built a giant postcard from Egypt and a life size replica of John Constable's *Salisbury Cathedral from the Meadows*, the latest challenge will be to build a giant version of the 'Pied Piper' in LEGO® bricks. This is based on Paul Kidby's beautiful artwork for Terry Pratchett's book 'The Amazing Maurice and his Educated Rodents' and is all part of the celebrations of the 'Terry Pratchett: HisWorld' exhibition currently on show at the museum.

All this building activity will take place in a marquee at the front of the museum. However, inside the museum there will be other exciting activities, including a Feegle trail and storytelling with Jo from Waterstones. To complete the construction experience, the Lecture Hall will be transformed into a workshop, with the chance to build an exclusive LEGO® brick model of the famous Discworld character, 'The Luggage' especially designed for this event, which visitors can purchase.

The museum shop will be full of gifts and cards, whilst The King's House Café will be serving a range of delicious, festive food.
