These include...

- [Conversation Club](#): A friendly monthly group for people who want to enjoy the museum's collections and make new connections with others.
- [The Meaning of Things](#): Our conversation project for small groups of people who don't usually visit the museum, exploring what things we keep and why we keep them.
- [Dementia Friendly Tours](#): Supported tours for groups and individuals led by our Dementia Friends staff and volunteers focussing on providing a social and learning experience.
- [Outreach in Care and Community Settings](#): We offer a range of object handling and reminiscence sessions for groups of people out in the community who may struggle to come to the museum or who already meet in a regular and familiar setting.
