

One way to make a cardboard box car

You will need:

Cardboard boxes

Scissors

Craft knife*

Marker pen/ felt tip

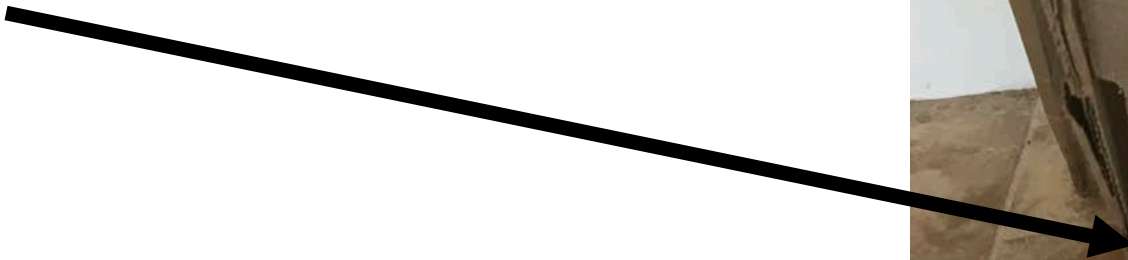
Tape for decorating (Gaffer tape)

*Find an adult to do the cutting with a craft knife



Cut off the flaps from the top of the box

Follow the dotted line all the way round the four sides of your box



Your box will now look like this!



Reinforce the bottom of your box with extra tape



Draw around a circular object like a plate to create a circle*

*This circle should be big enough for a child to stand into and be able to pull the box up, covering their torso



Once the circle is drawn, cut this out*

*using a craft knife will ensure the shape is cut whole

Put the circular cardboard piece to one side



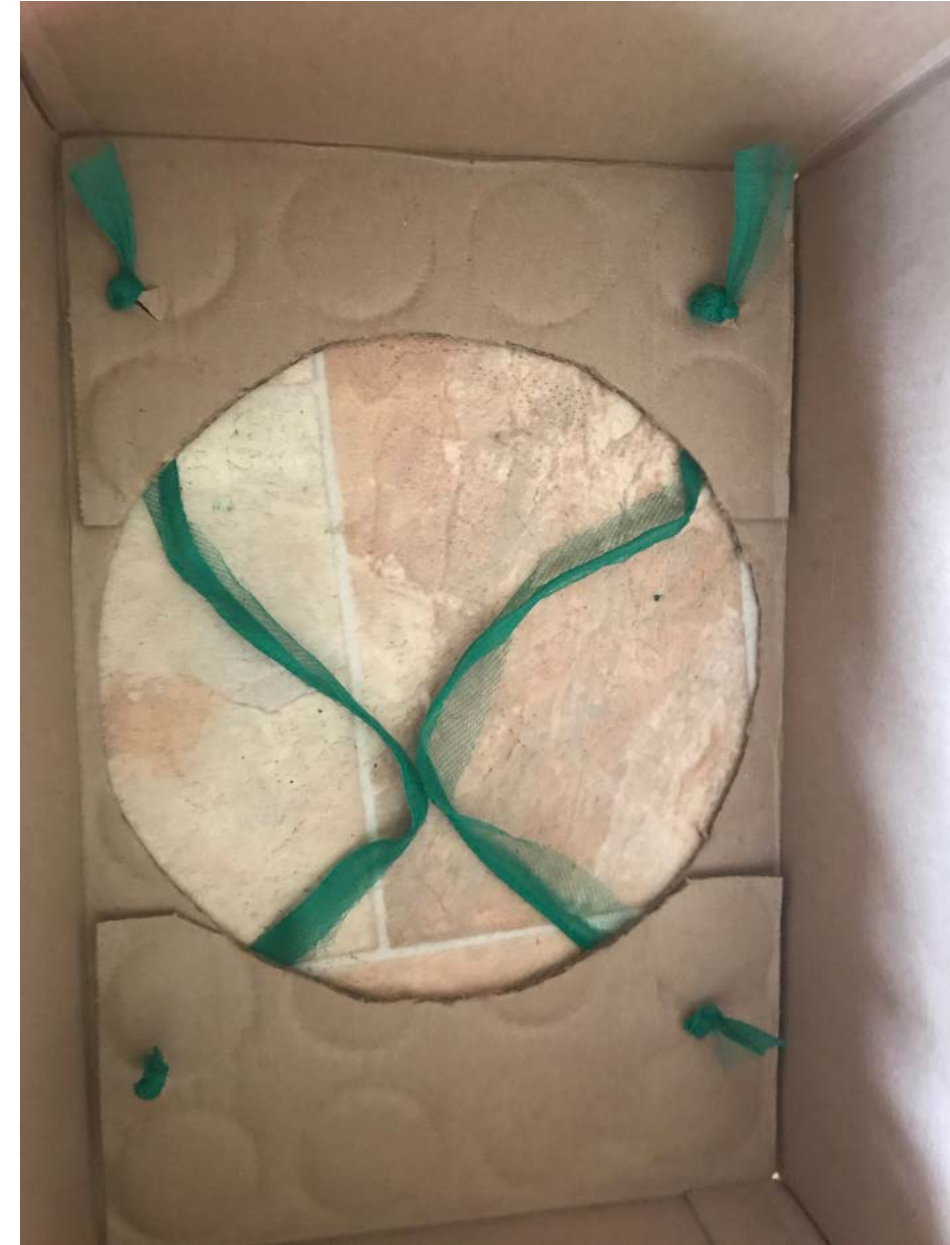
Cut an arch on the bottom edge of one of the (shorter sided) sides

This will create room for a child's legs if playing with the car sitting down



Make shoulder straps for the car by piercing four holes, two either edge of your circle

You can then thread ribbon or string through and knot each end on the underside of the box



Enjoy decorating your car!

Gaffer tape works well but use what you have

Any of the following could be great for decorating:

- Paint
- Tissue paper
- Crayons and felt tips
- Sticking drawings onto the sides



You could make a steering wheel
out of the cut-out circle
